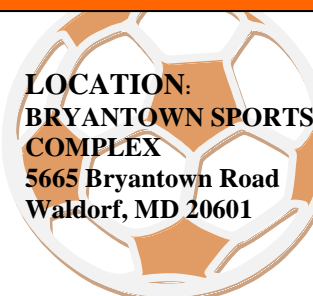
## Cancellation Policy
